<p>The teacher will divide students into groups and review vocabulary word. Teacher will have the students have simple conversations with each other.</p> <p>Example:</p> <p>“What is your favorite sport?” “My favorite sport is Baseball” “Baseball is so much fun to play.” “Lets play right now.”</p> <p>The students will play charades basketball. Procedure			
Warm-up	Teaching Aids	Time	Assessment (Competency)
Introduce the children to English Village and introduce the unit by asking the children if they like sports. Ask the students what kind of sports they like to play, or what kind of sports they like to watch. Teacher can even ask which sports the students dislike.		5 minutes	
Presentation & Practice	Teaching Aids	Time	Assessment (Competency)
<p>Practice simple conversation about sports.</p> <p>Review vocabulary word with students and use them in complete sentences. Teacher can show videos of the actual sports and describe what the object of the sport is.</p> <p>7th grade will have additional vocabulary words.</p> <p>Have the students write out names of sport next to pictures of the sport while projecting powerpoint. This will give students a reference of the sport.</p> <p>Vocabulary words. Baseball, Tennis, running, swimming, soccer, basketball, football, surfing, gymnastics,</p> <p>7th grade additional words.</p> <p>Racket, glove, bat, shoes, goggles, slam dunk, goal, touchdown, homerun, surfboard, fast, team sport, individual sport.</p>	Projector,	<p>5 minutes</p> <p>10 minutes</p>	

Production			
<p>The teacher will divide students into groups and review vocabulary word. Teacher will have the students have simple conversations with each other.</p> <p>Example:</p> <p>“What is your favorite sport?” “My favorite sport is Baseball” “Baseball is so much fun to play.”</p> <p>Students will play a review game called review basketball where they will be shown a picture of the sport if they can guess the name they will receive a point. Students can earn an extra point by shooting a ball into a trashcan when they present the correct answer.</p> <p>The students will also play charades. In this game student will be given a sport at random to act out and try to get the other students to guess what sport they are acting out. When a student guesses the sport they can be the next one selected to act out the next sport.</p> <p>Also depending on the English level, middle scholars might engage in whole conversation about sports. To start off the class might engage in a conversation such as “what is your favorite sport?” more advance conversations might be spoken in Chinese and then translated into English. Students will be encouraged to have whole conversations in English including a greeting a topic and saying goodbye. Role playing activities where students come up with their own dialog will also be encouraged for higher English level students.</p>		15-20 Minutes
