Dialogue	S1: "How do you make sticky rice animals?" S2: "Make the shapes of different animals." S1: "Do you like turtle begging?" S2: "Yes, I always win!"
Teaching Materials	PPT BINGO cards and markers Culture situational classroom

Time	Procedure	Teaching Material	Learning Expectation
25 minutes	The teacher introduces new vocabulary while the students locate the objects around the room.	PPT, culture classroom	Students learn new vocabulary words.
20 minutes	The class reviews the words and plays BINGO to further review new vocabulary.	BINGO	Students identify the vocabulary using the game BINGO.
15 minutes	The teacher guides a review game activity for students to practice identifying each object they have learned.	PPT	Students gain practice identifying these words.
